S.R.O No.798/2002.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 24 of the Kerala Road Fund Act, 2001 (10 of 2001) the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendments to their notification No.16432/D3/01/PWD dated the 15th September 2001 published as S.R.O. No.862/2001 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.1380 dated the 15th September, 2001 in which the user fees leviable under sub-section (1) of the said section on vehicles entering on the Mattancherry Bridge constructed by M/s. Cochin Bridge Infrastructure Co.Ltd. has been declared namely :-

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The new Mattancherry Bridge at Kochi was constructed on BOT basis in accordance with the tripartite agreement among Government of Kerala, Greater Cochin Development Authority and M/s. Gammon India Ltd. As per the agreement, the concessionaire company is entitled for collection of user fees and its annual revision. The Greater Cochin Development Authority has requested Government to revise the existing rates of user fee as per S.R.O. No.862/01 dated 15.9.2001 which is leviable under sub section (2) of section 24 of the Kerala Road Fund Act, 2001 by the concessionaire, i.e., M/s. Cochin Bridge Infrastructure Co. Ltd. as per the concession agreement. Government have considered the request and have decided to authorise the concessionaire M/s. Cochin Bridge Infrastructure Co. Ltd., to collect the revised rate of user fee on vehicles entering the Mattancherry Bridge in accordance with the provision of the agreement.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
